## **V. Essay**

After reading the brief biographical sketch of Mrs. Kate Swift Reese below, please write an essay describing how your being the recipient of the Kate Swift Reese Scholarship would honor the life of Mrs. Reese. The essay should be typewritten and 250-300 words in length.

Kate Swift was born in Watauga County in 1900 and was one of twelve children, of which only six survived to adulthood. She married Asa Reese on New Year's day 1921, and together they raised their 10 children. Kate Swift Reese was no ordinary woman. She taught school for a brief period of time before starting her large family. The Reese family lived on a farm in the Beaver Dam community and the majority of the family was born/or lived through the "Great Depression." She cooked three meals a day, tended a garden, made clothes for the children, washed their clothes with soap that she made, and canned meat and vegetables that were raised on the farm. She made certain that everyone attended church on Sunday and she even found time to prepare and teach Sunday School for more than thirty years. Not only did she provide for and look after her family, but she also gave assistance and encouragement to anyone in the community who needed help. She belonged to the "Beaver Dam Home Demonstration Club" which was organized by the North Carolina Agriculture Extension Service for the purpose of informing homemakers on all aspects of family living. She assisted with 4-H club work and projects in the family and in the community. After most of the children left home she stayed involved with the Agriculture Extension Service by attending meetings and talking to various groups throughout the state. She traveled to Hawaii and Washington DC and to other places in the US to attend educational meetings and would then report back at the county or state level. Many in Watauga County and throughout the state have attested to the fact that Kate Reese has made a difference in the lives of those that she touched. Certainly those of her family will agree that through her teachings and encouragement of the importance of education and moral living that she has made a difference in their lives.
